PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 4 (1) (aa) TNP Act and Transport Act r/w 24 TNP Act in Crime No.108 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

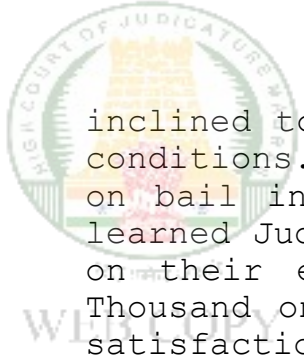
2.The case of the prosecution is that 408 bottles of liquor was recovered from A1. This petitioners are the Supervisor and Sales Man of the TASMAC shop. Therefore, the respondent Police registered a case in Crime No.108 of 2018.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that A1 was already arrested and released on bail. The petitioners herein are only Supervisor and Sales Man of the TASMAC shop and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent Police would submit that totally 408 bottles of liquor was seized from A1 and A1 was arrested and later, released on bail. He would further submit that there is no previous case pending against the petitioners.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is



inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rameswaram, Ramanathapuram District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
