3.Considering the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner/S, the delay of 121 days is condoned on payment of cost of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) to the Rojavanam, Homeless & Aged



Care Centre, Melur Road, Uthangudi, Madurai, Within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed automatically, without further reference to this court.
