PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending his arrest by the respondent police based on the Non Bailable Warrant issued by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge(F.T.C.), Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District in S.C.No.148 of 2016.

2.The petitioner was absent on 25.10.2016 during the trial in S.C.No.148 of 2016 before the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge(F.T.C.), Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District. Therefore, Non-Bailable Warrant came to be issued.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall appear before the Court below regularly on all future hearing dates without fail.

4.If the petitioner fails to appear before the Court below for future hearings, he is entitled to file appropriate petition under Section 317 Cr.P.C. Even if on one hearing, he is absent and no application is filed for condoning his absence, this order granting anticipatory bail shall stand cancelled.

5.Recording the abovesaid undertaking given by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the petitioner is permitted to appear before the trial Court on next hearing date and to file a



recall warrant petition. The learned Additional District and Sessions Judge(F.T.C.), Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, is directed to recall the warrant on the same day.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is allowed.
