PRAYER IN WP(MD)NO.14521 OF 2018: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order in Na.Ka.No.834/A4/2018-2019, dated 25.6.2018 on the file of the third respondent and to quash the same as illegal and consequently for a direction to the third respondent to forward the proposal of the Petitioner seeking reemployment to the second respondent and for a direction to the second respondent to grant re-employment to the Petitioner from 1.7.2018 to 31.5.2019 in accordance with the Government Order in G.O.Ms.No.300, Higher Education Department(F1) Department dated 8.9.2006 within the time stipulated by this Court.

PRAYER IN WP(MD)NO.15066 OF 2018: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order in Se.MU.Na.Ka.No.879/R.Se/O.Na/Tha.Pa.EN2/2010/Ka,dated 25.6.2018 on the file of the third respondent and quash the same as illegal and consequently to direct the respondents to provide provisional pension to the Petitioner until completion of the disciplinary proceedings and other benefits such as provident fund, special provident fund, Encashment of Earned Leave Surrender, Gratuity etc
