PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is in judicial custody since 04.06.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.383 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police. He seeks bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police.

3.Considering the fact that the injured person has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(ii) The petitioner shall not abscond. In view of the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl OP(MD)No.11861 of 2018 dated 13.07.2018 regarding execution of sureties in Crime No.382 of 2018, the same condition need not be imposed in Crime No.383 of 2018.



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(iii) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
