Civil Revision Petition is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, praying to set aside the order and decreetal order dated 23.11.2015 of the Principal District Munsif of Kuzhithurai in I.A.No.645 of 2015 in O.S.No.147 of 2014 on his file dismissing the said I.A.

Prayer in CRP(MD). 410/ 2016 :

Civil Revision Petition is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, praying to set aside the order and decreetal order dated 30.11.2015 of the learned Principal District Munsif of Kuzhithurai in I.A.No.645 of 2015 in O.S.No.147 of 2014 on his file, dismissing the said I.A.

Thereafter, on 24.06.2019, this Court granted two months time to comply with the order of this Court, dated 28.08.2018. However, since the O.S.Nos.147 of 2014 and 16 of 2012 could not be disposed of within the time stipulated by this Court, the Court below, sought for two months time. Hence, the matter is listed before this Court today.

2. Considering the reasons stated by the Court below for extension of time, time is extended for a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, to comply with the order of this Court, dated 28.08.2018.
