This petition is filed to condone the delay of 292 days in filing the above said appeal.

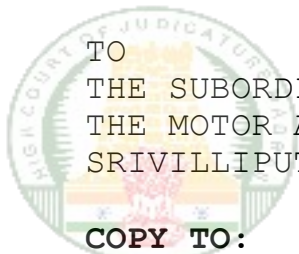
2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
