3.It is a case of double murder. The accused appeared to have formed an unlawful assembly and had attacked the unarmed victims. Since, the matter involves the murder of two unarmed women, this issue viewed by this Court seriously.

4.Taking note of the serious allegations made against the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.



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5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
