PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.3, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 354(D) and 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.207 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is actually aged about 18 years and it was wrongly mentioned as 17 years. It is also seen that the primary allegations are only against the first accused and the petitioner is only said to have only accompanied the main accused.

4.Taking note of the limited role played by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain other conditions, because of this aspect alone. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumangalam, Madurai District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner



shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
