PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

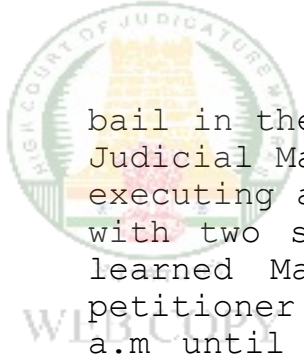
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 307 and 506(ii) I.P.C. in Crime No.260 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to business rivalry between the brother-in-law of the defacto complainant and the petitioner with regard to procuring the milk from local people so as to sell the same in a large quantity to the society, the petitioner and others assaulted the defacto complainant and cut the hand of the defacto complainant's brother-in-law. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent submitted that the investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on



bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ambasamuthiram, Tirunelveli District and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
