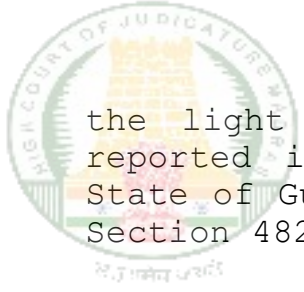
ORDER

The Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash to the case in C.C.No.185 of 2015 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Court No.1, Thoothukudi, for the alleged offences under Sections 294 (b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC.

2. The case is still in the stage of trial. By passage of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3. A Joint Memo of Compromise has been filed before this Court which have been signed by the petitioners and the second respondent and also by their respective counsel. The parties were also present before the Court and they were identified by Mr.P.Veerabagu, Special Sub Inspector of Police and they have also produced the copies of the Aadhaar Card which are made part of the record. This Court also enquired both the parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the proceedings in CC No.185 of 2015 pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In



the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath), this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the proceedings in CC. No.185 of 2015.

5. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in CC No.185 of 2015, on the file of the Judicial Magistrate -I, Thoothukudi, is quashed and the terms of Joint Compromise Memo shall form part and parcel of this order. The petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.750/- (Rupees Seven Hundred and Fifty only) to the credit of "District Siddha Medical Officer, CCRI, Periyakulam" (payable in Account No.10767823177, SBI, Periyakulam), within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.
