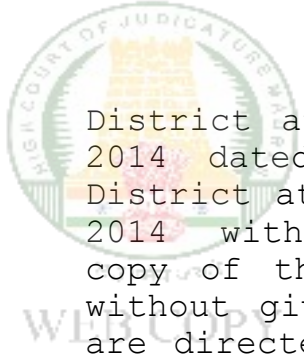
O R D E R

The petitioner has come forward with this Civil Revision Petition to call for the records pertaining to fair and decreetal order in I.A.No.35 of 2015 in DOP No.167 of 2014 dated 29.01.2016 on the file of the learned District Judge, Kanyakumari District at Nagercoil.

2. The petitioner has filed a I.D.O.P. No.167 of 2014 before the learned District Judge, Kanyakumari District at Nagercoil seeking to dissolve the marriage. During the pendency of the petition, the respondent/petitioner filed I.A.No.35 of 2015 to pass an order directing the respondent to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) per month as interim alimony and a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) towards litigation expenses and the trial Court has allowed the interlocutory application. Aggrieved over the same, the revision petitioner has come forward with this Civil Revision Petition.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the revision petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent and perused the documents available on record.

4. Considering the nature of the case, this Court is not inclined to allow the Civil Revision Petition. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition is dismissed by confirming the fair and decreetal order passed by the learned District Judge, Kanyakumari
