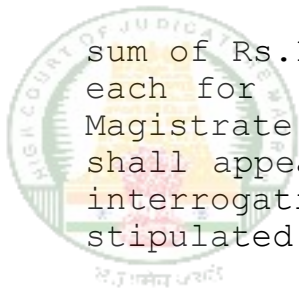
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b), 323, 324 and 307 of I.P.C., in Crime No.34 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. In view of the conduct of the petitioners, this Court directed the petitioners to apologise to the victim. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that they went to the house of the victim to express their regrets. However, the victim did not accept their apologies.

3. In view of the expression of contrition on the part of the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudukulathur, and executing a bond each of them for a



sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

4. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
