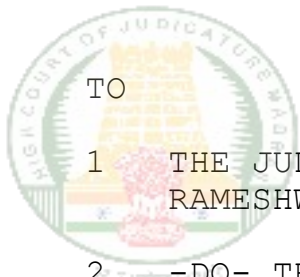
2. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.
