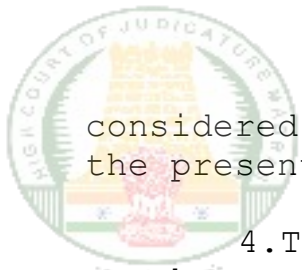

ORDER

Mr.M.Murugan, learned Government Advocate takes notice on behalf of the respondents.

2.By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3.It is the grievance of the petitioner that his representation dated 08.02.2018, seeking for receive the documents and register the same with regard to property in Survey No.643/1B-2A to an extent of 800 sq.ft. Situated at Chettinayakkanpatti Village, Dindigul Taluk, Dindigul District, has not been



considered by the respondents till date and therefore, has filed the present writ petition.

4.This Court has not expressed any of its view with regard to the merits of the representation made by the petitioner. It is needless to point out that whenever representation of this nature is made, the respondents are duty bound to consider the same in one way or other. Non consideration of the same would amount to dereliction of their ordinary duties of their office and as such this Court would be justified in invoking its powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to direct him to consider the petitioner's representation within a stipulated time.

5.In view of the limited prayer sought for in this writ petition, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 08.02.2018, on its own merits and take further action in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Such an exercise shall be made, after conducting enquiry and giving due opportunity to the petitioner as well as to any other persons, who may be interested in the subject matter.

6.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
