PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

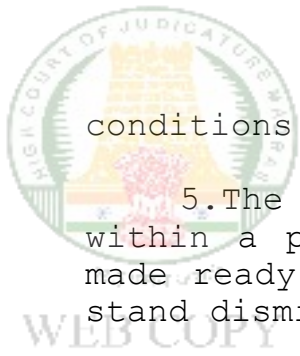
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 379 I.P.C., in Crime No.84 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The defacto complainant has given a complaint stating that his hens worth about Rs.6,000/- were stolen.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner would pay a sum of Rs.3,000/- to the defacto complainant.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Sivagangai, and executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the



conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

5.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
