The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Section 379 I.P.C., seeks anticipatory bail.

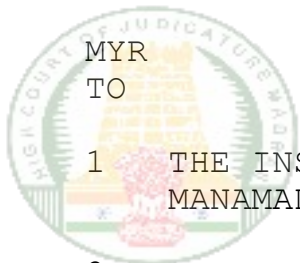
2.It is a case of theft, which has taken place in train journey. The petitioner is having a previous case. The matter calls for investigation and interrogation of the petitioner is also warranted.
