PRAYER IN C.M.A(MD).No.582 of 2018:

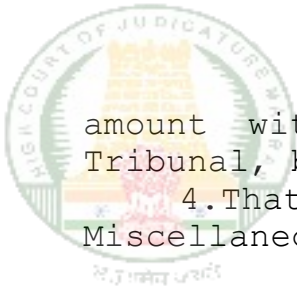
