3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent would submit that there are three previous cases are pending against the petitioner in similar nature of offence.

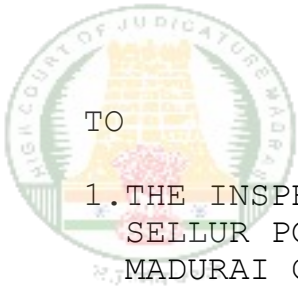
3.During the time of occurrence, 1.200 kgs of ganja was recovered from the petitioner.
