PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

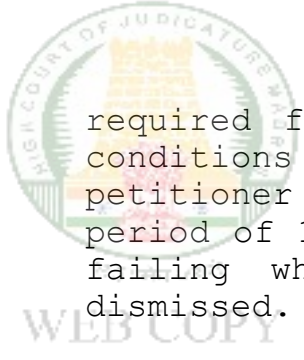
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 8(C) r/w 20 (b) (ii) B of NDPS Act in Crime No.195 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police.

3.The quantity of ganja is a small one. Property was recovered only from the second accused. Accused 2 and 3 were arrested. Based on their confession, the petitioner was implicated. The petitioner is not having any previous case.

4.Therefore, this Court grants anticipatory bail to the petitioner only because the petitioner is not having any previous case. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Principal Special Court for EC & NDPS Act Court, Madurai and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when



required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
