3.This Court went through the contents of the First Information Report. It is alleged that the accused had gone to the defacto complainant's shop in the guise of making some purchase of sarees. But, they had tried to commit theft of sarees that have been kept



for sale. Taking note of the nature of allegations made in the First Information Report, this Court is of the view that the petitioners are not entitled to grant of anticipatory bail. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
