ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 447, 294(b), 324, 427 & 506(ii) IPC and Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) r/w 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Caste and The Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015 in Crime No.587 of 2017 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent.

3.The petitioners are permitted to surrender before the Jurisdictional Special Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioners are permitted to inform the defacto complainant by a registered post regarding their date of surrender, when they apply for regular bail.

4.The jurisdictional Special Court is directed to consider and dispose of the petitioners' bail application on the same day of surrender. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
