Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 25.07.2018 and to direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to conduct the Kabadi Tournament which is scheduled to be held on 04.08.2018 and 05.08.2018 at the land belongs to one Dhanam, W/o Arumugam in Survey No.39/4 (extent of 44 cents) situated at Earkudi, Atchampathu Village, Madurai District and to provide adequate police protection.

2.By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3.According to the petitioner, he made a representation, dated 25.07.2018, seeking to permit the petitioner to conduct the Kabadi Tournament which is scheduled to be held on 04.08.2018 and 05.08.2018 at the land belonging to one Dhanam, W/o Arumugam, in Survey No.39/4 (extent of 44 cents), situated at Earkudi, Atchampathu Village, Madurai District and to provide adequate police protection. No order has been passed till date. Hence, the petitioner filed this present writ petition before this Court.



4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation filed by the petitioner would be considered by the third respondent in accordance with law.

5.In the light of the above facts and circumstances, and considering the limited scope of prayer, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs the third respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 25.07.2018 on merits and in accordance with law, on or before 03.08.2018, after providing an opportunity to the parties concerned.

6.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
