ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.D.SIVARAMAN, Advocate for the petitioner and Respondents 1,2 & 6 not appeared either in person or by an advocate , the court made the following order:-

Considering the contention of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the delay is condoned on payment of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) to Rojavanam, Home for Old Aged, Melur Road, Uthangudi-Ulaganeri, Madurai-625 107 within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, the petition shall stand dismissed automatically, without further reference to this Court.
