PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

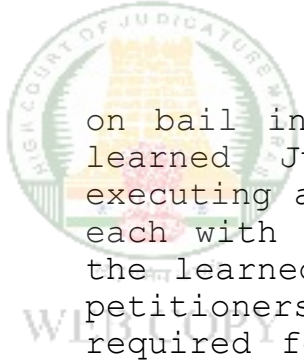
The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 417, 420, 294(b), 506(ii) I.P.C in Crime No.208 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.Due to matrimonial dispute, the defacto complainant lodged a complaint against the petitioners herein. The petitioners are only the parents of A1. The real dispute in this case is only between A1 and the defacto complainant. This Court has already referred the matter for mediation in order to resolve the dispute between A1 and the defacto complainant.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released



on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Vedasanthur and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
