PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 506(i) IPC r/w Section 67(A) of Information Technology Act, 2005 in Crime No. Not Known of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

3.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the State.

4.The petitioner is said to be constantly harassing the defacto



complainant. Since safety of women is involved, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
