PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who is arrayed as accused No.3 and 4, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 (sand Theft) IPC in Crime No.138 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are innocent persons and they did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State would submit that the petitioners have no previous case.

5.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nanguneri, and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction



of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
