PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.2, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 IPC in Crime No.290 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the State would submit that the petitioner is having one previous case and that is also for the same nature of offence.

4.Taking note of the bad antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
