PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

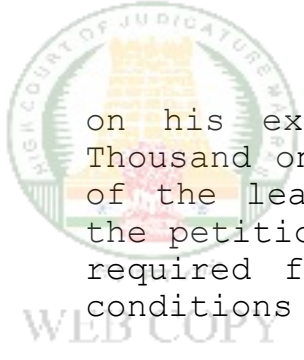
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.1, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A) IPC and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act in Crime No.34 of 2017, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the defacto complainant already filed maintenance case and it was also ordered. The learned counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner undertakes that the first accused will honour the maintenance order every month.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

5.Recording the said undertaking given by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, Theni District, and



on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
