PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

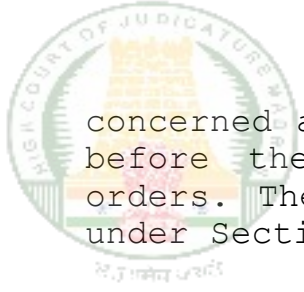
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 188, 341, 294(b), 153(A), 353, 506(ii) I.P.C, in Crime No.403 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 13.09.2018 Vinayagar Chathurthi festival conducted by the Shencottai Vinayagar Temple. On that day, the petitioner and others assaulted an another group. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that the petitioner is a history sheeted rowdy element. Hence, he opposed to grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottai and on his executing a bond for a sum of RS.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate



concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
