ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 and 2, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 353, 379, 307 IPC and Section 21 (i) of Mines and Minerals in Crime No.107 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

Taking note of the quantity of the contraband, this Court is not



inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
