3. From the report submitted through the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, it appears that the petitioner was involved in 17 cases. Furthermore, even on the earlier occasion, when parole was granted, he was involved in an offence. Pursuant to which, a case has been registered against him. The report also shows that there is a likelihood of law and order problem, if he is released on parole. Thus, we do not find any merit in this petition. Accordingly, the Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
