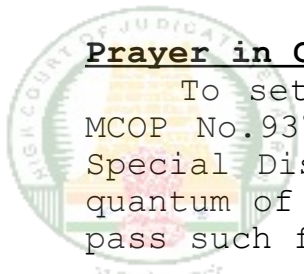

ORDER : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.V.NIRMAL KUMAR, Advocate for the Appellant in Both Petitions and of Mr.J.S.MURALI, Advocate for the Second Respondent in Both Petitions, the court made the following order:-
