PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

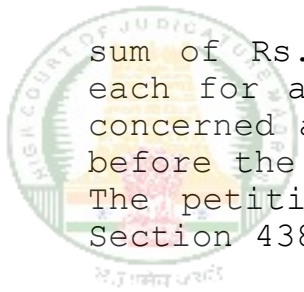
The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1-A) @ 4(1)(aaa), 4(1)(A) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act read with Sections 417 and 420 I.P.C, in Crime No.248 of 2017, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that while at the time of vehicle check up, the petitioner was found in possession of 12 bottles of 750 ml Race Whisky, totalling 24 bottles of fake liquors for selling. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the contraband was recovered by the respondent police and the investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alangulam and on his executing a bond for a



sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
