Muthukamatchi, aged about 34 years, daughter of the petitioner from the illegal custody of the 3rd respondent before this Court and set her at liberty.

Heard the learned Counsel on either side.

2. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the third respondent. The investigation reveals that the petitioner brought money from the third respondent. For non-payment, the third respondent sent his wife. Thereafter, she did not return. Alleging that the third respondent is threatening her, the petitioner also filed a suit, in the month of July, 2018. The present complaint was also closed, in view of the statement made by the petitioner, in writing, stating



that no further enquiry is required.

3. Thus, we do not find any illegal detention involved in the present case. Accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
