Prayer in CMA(MD) No.SR30562 of 2018:-

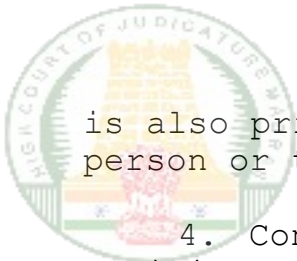
