PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 3 of Tamil Nadu Public Property (Prevention of Damage and loss) Act, 1992, in Crime No.141 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 09.07.2018 at about 06.10.p.m., the petitioner and other accused were pelted stone on the glass of the Government bus and damaged the glass worth about Rs.10,000/-. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner on condition that the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the credit of the Crime No.141 of 2018, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Tirunelveli and on such deposit, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Tirunelveli and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the



learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30.a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
