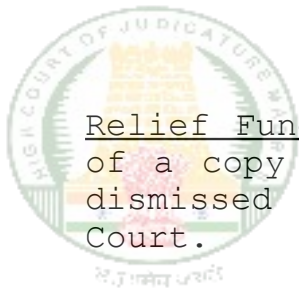
PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR8591 of 2018
