PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/A2 and A3, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody since 20.10.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 506(ii) of I.P.C. read with Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.583 of 2018 , on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 19.10.2018, the petitioners and other accused waylaid the defacto complainant and demanded money and abused him and also attacked with hand by using foul and filthy language and snatched the cell phone worth about Rs.28,000/-. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offence.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police would submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and the investigation is pending.



6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;

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(i) each of the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) each to the credit of crime No.583 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Shencottah;

(ii) on such deposit, each of the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sencottah;

(iii) the petitioners shall appear before the respondent daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.
