PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

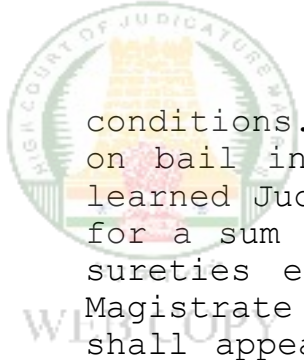
The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 324 and 506(ii) I.P.C in Crime No.382 of 2018, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 30.09.2018, due to civil dispute between the parties, the first accused assaulted the defacto complainant with aruval and thereby, he sustained injury. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocents. They did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution. They have been falsely implicated in this case. The first and second accused have been granted anticipatory bail before the trial Court in Cr.M.P.No.5605 of 2018, dated 08.10.2018. Hence, he prays for anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that the first petitioner is having five previous cases and the investigation is pending.

5.Taking note of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain



conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alankulam and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate Court within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
