ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

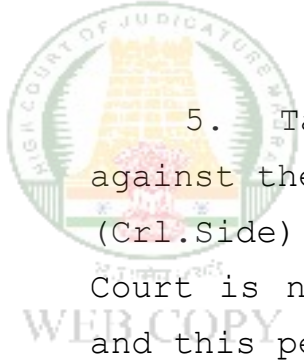

5. Taking into consideration the nature of allegations against the petitioner and the submission of the Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that the petitioner is involved in previous case, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and this petition is dismissed.
