ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No. Not known of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) for the respondent police submitted that a case has been registered in Crime No.962 of 2018 under Section 75 of the Tamil Nadu Madras City Police Act, on 15.11.2018. He further submitted that the petitioner has admitted his guilt and paid a sum of Rs.1,000/- before the lower Court.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), this petition is dismissed as not maintainable.
