J U D G M E N T

The Transport Corporation is on appeal aggrieved by the award of Rs.2,24,000/- for the injuries suffered by the claimant.

2. The only contention raised by the learned counsel for the Transport Corporation is that the Tribunal has awarded Rs.4,000/- per percentage of disability.

3. Even assuming that the said award could be said to be in excess by overall sum of Rs.8,000/-, considering the fact that the award under the heads of attendant charges and loss of income during treatment are low. I do not find that the overall award calls for interference in the hands of this Court. Hence, the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is dismissed without being admitted. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
