2.In view of the endorsement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this criminal original petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

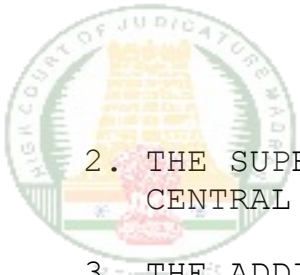
