2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner had received the order copy on 26.10.2018 and thereafter, he had suffered with Dengue/Swine Flue and he has taking treatment from 05.11.2018 to 20.11.2018.

3. In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to produce sureties as per the order of this court, dated 08.10.2018. The petitioner ought to have executed sureties within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The learned counsel would submit that now sureties are available and he is ready to comply with the conditions.

4. In view of the same, time granted by this Court to comply with the directions imposed vide order, dated 08.10.2018 in Crl.O.P.No.17811 of 2018 is extended for a period of two weeks from



the date of receipt of amended copy of this order.
