ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 498(A), 506(ii) of IPC. And Section 4 of TNPWH Act & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, in Crime No. Not Known of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.
