PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(2)(c) & 5(i)(a) of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956 in Crime No.6 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant has lodged a complaint before the respondent police stating that the petitioner and other accused said to have showed some absence photos in their mobile phone.
