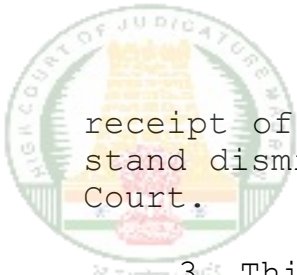
PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR18625 of 2018:-
