Therefore, the respondent police called the petitioners for enquiry, since three cases are pending as against the first petitioner.



4. Admittedly, no case is pending as against the second and third petitioners. If the respondent police wants to enquire the petitioners, the same can be done only by issuing a proper summons to the petitioners.

5. The petitioners shall not be harassed in the name of enquiry since they are not involved in any other criminal offences.
