ORDER

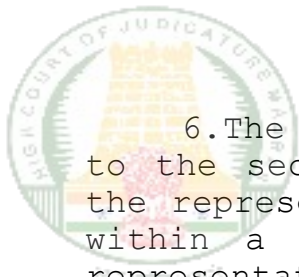
Mr.B.Bhagawathi, learned Government Advocate, takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2.

2. By consent of both the parties, the main Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission.

3.This Writ Petition has been filed for a direction to the second respondent to provide Police protection for the petitioner to fence his property, which has also been surveyed by the Tahsildar.

4.The petitioner has already given a representation dated 02.08.2018 to the second respondent.

5.However, the learned Government Advocate would submit that the representation has not been received by the second respondent.



6.The petitioner is directed to submit a fresh representation to the second respondent and the second respondent shall consider the representation and take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the representation from the petitioner.

7.The Writ Petition is disposed of with the above directions.
